We recognise the importance of protecting the privacy of information collected about visitors to our website, in particular information that is capable of identifying an individual ("personal information") and as such is bound by the Australian Privacy Principles set out in the Privacy Act 1998 (Cth). Collecting Personal Information

Personal information about visitors to our site is collected only when knowingly and voluntarily submitted. - the purpose of the collection

Where information about an individual is collected from a third party, we will take reasonable steps to notify the individual of the above information.

Use of Information
